After Action Report MIAP Mission, Quantico National Cemetery 12 April 2017

On 12 April 2017, the Missing In American Project laid to rest at Quantico National Cemetery the previously unclaimed cremains of a veteran and the spouse of a veteran.

The veteran was provided by the Prince William County Sheriff's Office, and the spouse was from Smith & Williams Funeral Home in Virginia Beach. The two groups converged into Quantico National Cemetery for the service at 1100hrs.

Present at the service were representatives of the Prince William Sheriff's Office, the Daughters of the American Revolution, the US Air Force Honor Guard (Joint Base Andrews, Maryland), along with riders from several different organizations.

The Dignified Transfer of Cremains from Virginia Beach occurred the day before and joined the veteran from Manassas at Quantico National Cemetery.

This event was supported by the Prince William County Sheriff's Office and the Prince William County Police Department. An NBC News reporter and cameraman from the local area attended this mission.
