HISTORY OF THE FALLEN RIDER RUN:

Thank you for joining us on this ride to remember those we have lost but will never be forgotten. The NOR-CAL FALLEN RIDER MEMORIAL RUN was started in 1998 as an impromptu remembrance ride to honor the memory of RON AND LOUISE KAGAN, a loss felt by many in the community.
