RECOVERED VETERAN FINAL HONORS INTERMENT CEREMONY

Thursday, September 28, 2017 1:00 PM

Civil War Veteran, Private Zachariah M. Stucker, Company A, 48th Illinois Infantry Regiment, was found deceased in his bed at Retsil Veterans' Home, Port Orchard, WA, at 7:30 PM, on June 28, 1914.

Private Stucker's remains were sent to Seattle for cremation. Somehow, the cremains never got returned to Retsil. For 103 years (and counting) Zach has been in temporary storage at Funeral Homes in Seattle, and Lake View Cemetery's storage service.

Since Zachariah Stucker was a resident and died at Retsil, the current Retsil management desires his return for interment. On Thursday, September 28, 2017, at 1:00 PM, Private Stucker will receive Final Military Honors and be interred with dignity at **Veterans Home Cemetery, on Olney Avenue, Port Orchard, Washington**. The public is invited to attend the ceremony. "Sons of the Union Veterans of the Civil War" will provide G.A.R. protocols.

Parking will be at the "Tractor Supply" parking lot, 1415 Olney Ave SE, corner of Olney Ave and Mile Hill Dr. (about 300 yards) uphill from the Cemetery. Shuttle service provided by the Veterans Home.
