At 11:00 hours on August 1st, 2024. Missouri State Miap conducted a service for 2 Unclaimed Veterans.

1 Post Vietnam Era US Navy Veteran Deceased in 2011 and One WWI Veteran Deceased in 1963 who was waiting for his final salute for over 61 years.

The cremains were recovered from Clinkingbeard Funeral Home in AVA Missouri.

The journey for these two veterans started in AVA Missouri at the Clinkingbeard Funeral home at 8:00 am driving north to Lebanon Mo, then west to Exit 156 on Missouri Interstate I-44 for a total distance of 112 Miles. Law enforcement Escort was provided by the AVA PD, The Mansfield PD and finally the Missouri State Troopers for the final 50 miles. Arriving at the Cemetery at 10:40 am
