MISSION STATEMENT

The purpose of the Missing in America Project (MIAP) is to locate, identify and inter the unclaimed cremated remains of American veterans through the joint efforts of private, state, and federal organizations, and to provide honor, respect, and dignity to those who have served this country by securing a final resting place for these forgotten heroes.

"IT'S THE RIGHT THING TO DO"

On Thursday, October 17, 2024, at 10:00am, MIAP – Florida, in cooperation with Yates Funeral Home and Cremation Services in Ft. Pierce, and the Miami-Dade County Medical Examiner Department's Indigent Cremation Services, will inter the unclaimed cremated remains of 17 veterans with full military honors, at the South Florida National Cemetery.

The veterans being interred served in the US Army, Marine Corps., Navy, and Air Force, during Korea, Vietnam, Persian Gulf, and other non-war specific periods. The longest that any of these that will be interred has been unclaimed is since 2010.

This service is open to all residents of our area communities.

There will be an escort of the Hearse led by the Palm Beach Sheriff's Office that will leave from the Southwest parking area (the Lantana Road side) of the Wellington South Super Target Store at 5900 Florida State Road 7 (Rt. 441), on the Northeast corner of State Road 7 and Lantana Road. All motorcycle organizations, riders, and vehicles are welcome to participate. Meeting time is 8:45am for a safety briefing, and the escort will depart (KSU) to the cemetery at 9:15am.
